MAKAR SANKRANTI: Sankranti occurs every month when the sun enters a new house of the zodiac. In Makar Sankranti (Jan 14th) the sun enters Capricorn which marks the start of the auspicious half of the year called Uttarayan, when the sun begins its northern course.

PURNIMAA: Full moon day of each month is dedicated to Lord Vishnu and is observed by performing Satyanarayan puja (full moon katha). In the month of July/August the full moon day is observed as GURU PURNIMAA to honor Vyasa and all gurus of the world.

CHATURTHI: The 4th lunar day of every fortnight is called Chaturthi, dedicated to Lord Ganesha. Once a year in the bright half of Bhadrapad, (Aug/Sept) this day marks the start of the 11 day Ganesha Utsav festival.

KRISHNA JANAM ASHTAMI: The birth anniversary of Lord Krishna. This is observed at the most auspicious midnight hour that comes under the influence of both Ashtami tithi and Rohini Nakshatra. Sometimes there are 2 days given for this festival. Smartha Hindus (those who worship all names of God), observe the festival on a particular day and Vaishnavite Hindus (who worship principally Lord Vishnu) occasionally observe it on the following day. Sometimes these dates coincide with each other.

KARTIKA PURNIMAA: On the full moon day of the month of Kartika (Oct/Nov) Ganga Devi is worshipped by doing puja on the banks of rivers/beaches, etc. and blessing sought by bathing in the water as a means of spiritual purification.

5 DAYS OF DIVALI:
 (1) **Dhanwanti Triodashi,** the anniversary of Lord Vishnu as Dhanwanti emerging from the churning of the ocean bearing medicinal herbs, when the Yam Deep is lit. This occurs 2 lunar days (sometimes 1 or sometimes 2 solar days) before Diwali.
 (2) **Narak Chaturthi,** the lunar day before Diwali which marks the anniversary of Lord Krishna defeating Narakasur.
 (3) **Deepavali/Divali,** when Lakshmi puja is performed. This falls on Amaavasya (dark night) of the month of Kartik.
 (4) **Govardhan Puja,** the day after Deepavali commemorates Lord Krishna protecting the residents of Vraj by lifting the mountain with the little finger of his left hand.
 (5) **Bhatri Dooj,** two lunar days after Deepavali where the bond within family members are celebrated.
